## **Home Energy Assistance Program**

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps qualified homeowners and renters pay for heating costs. You may also qualify for other programs. This includes weatherization services, heating system repairs, and annual cleaning and evaluation of your heating system. A yearly inspection and service may help your heating system last longer and run better. This can help keep you safe and comfortable. It can also help you save money.

### **Who is eligible for HEAP?**

Anyone who may need help paying for heat should apply even if your application has been turned down before. HEAP benefits are based on your household size, income, and home energy costs. Apply even if you may be over the income limits, because there may be adjustments made to your income used for HEAP eligibility.

### **What if my heat is included in my rent?**

You can still apply even if heat is part of your rent.

### **How do I apply?**

Call your local community action agency as soon as you can because appointments fill up fast. Ask what you need to bring with you. You can also apply over the phone.
